- Costing: follow up to ensure we are meeting defined cost targets and deadlines with factories.
- Work with external factories and suppliers to:
  - O Define technical specifications for production (materials, decor, sizing), regularly review ongoing developments working with factories directly to give the green light for production.
  - o Ensure that we are meeting quality standards with our factories and quality team.
